## Danes Kicking Up a Storm!

In the **Atmospheric Conference**, the **Madison Danes** posted a TML best **22-8** record in May and took over 1<sup>st</sup> place in the **Robinson Division** by 2 games over **Duluth** (14-16 in May). **Vanderlyle** (17-13) is only 5 games behind now at .500. **Madison** had thought of rebuilding, but may have to change course now! In the **Gatto, New York** (18-12) maintained a 9-game lead over both **Santa Ana** (18-12) and **Beverly** (16-14). In the **Pertierra, Toxic Waste** (17-13) has pulled to 1 game behind leader **Chesapeake** (16-14). Those two do not meet until September!

Over in the **Oceanic Conference**, the **'Skayuna Squires** posted a **19-11** record in May, but **Vegas** (19-11) paced them and remain 3 back in the **Steinmetz Division**. **Albany** (18-12) slipped to 5 games behind. **Marco Island** (18-12) has a 6-game lead in the **Williams** over **Walla Walla** (18-12) who improved to .500. In the **Ruth, Kentucky** (18-12) took over the lead, now 4 games ahead of **Arkansas** (14-16) who had a losing month.

The batting leader is still **Toxic Waste's Aaron Judge** with **.358** AVG, now only 2 points ahead of **Chesapeake's Trea Turner!** **Judge** leads in OBP (.448), SLG (.679) and RC (59). **Turner** leads in Hits (85). The HR leader is still **Murderous's Eugenio Suarez** now with 23. **Suarez** is tied with **Marco Island's Giancarlo Stanton** for the RBI lead with 51. The SB leader is Kentucky's Francisco Lindor (24 SB, 5 CS).

The new ERA leader is **Chesapeake's Ryne Nelson** at **1.83**, well ahead of **Arkansas's Paul Skenes** (2.31). There are 11 qualified pitchers with an ERA under 3. The victories leader is **Kentucky's Logan Webb** (8-2). The Strikeout leader is still **Glenmont's Tarik Skubal** with 120 K. The Saves leader is still **Arkansas's Brad Keller** (16/17 SVO, 25 GR, 1.15).
